1 **WHEREAS, Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service, Substance Abuse**
2 **and Mental Health Services Administration, Center for Substance Abuse Treatment,**
3 **Targeted Capacity Expansion Grant awarded a no cost extension to the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation Department of Human Services; Division of Alcoholism and**
5 **Substance Abuse; to provide continuation of substance abuse services on the Nation;**

7 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has notified the Division of Alcoholism and Substance**
8 **Abuse Program of a decrease in the Indirect Cost from 17.4% to 14.3% effective**
9 **10/01/01; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has notified the Division of Alcoholism and Substance**
11 **Abuse Program of available carryover dollars for FY 2002 in the sum of \$180,273.85.**
12 **This budget as submitted was approved by the Executive Branch that operates the**
13 **Department of Human Services and now is being submitted to the Tohono O'odham**
14 **Legislative Council for review and approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 16 **1. It hereby approves and authorizes expenditures of the \$180,273.57 with the**
17 **attached budget modification #1 description.**
- 18 **2. It hereby approves and authorizes the addition of new line items listed on**
19 **attached budget modification #1.**
- 20 **3. It hereby approves the Division of Alcoholism & Substance Abuse Program of a**
21 **decrease in the Indirect Cost from 17.4% to 14.3% effective 10/01/01 and transfers**
22 **Indirect Cost funds into established line items where additional funds are**
23 **needed.**
- 24 **4. It hereby approves the carryover dollars for FY 2002 in the sum of \$180,273.57 for**
25 **the Alcoholism & Substance Abuse Program, Account #11-1456, Targeted**
26 **Expansion.**
- 27 **5. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized**
28 **to negotiate and execute the contract.**
