

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an Application for a P. L. 93-638 Construction Contract with the Bureau of Reclamation for Remaining Construction Activities on Schuk Toak Farm)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-273

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") is in the final stages of completing the**
2 **construction of a distribution system for delivery of Central Arizona Project water to**
3 **the Nation at the Schuk Toak Farm under Grant Agreement No. 6-FG-32-00100 with**
4 **the Bureau of Reclamation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Nation and the Bureau of Reclamation have identified additional work that needs**
6 **to be completed, which stand largely outside the original scope of work in Grant**
7 **Agreement No. 6-FG-32-00100; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation seeks to apply for a new P. L. 93-638 Construction Contract, pursuant to 25**
9 **CFR, Subpart J, §900.100 et seq., with the Bureau of Reclamation as attached and**
10 **incorporated by this reference to finance the remaining construction items which**
11 **include, but are not necessarily limited to shade structures, main access road,**
12 **chemical storage facility, and general remediation needed on Schuk Toak New Farm**
13 **Development.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
15 **the submission of the attached application to enter into a new Construction Contract**
16 **under 25 CFR, Subpart J, §900.110 et seq., with the Bureau of Reclamation to finance**
17 **the remaining construction items that were not included in the original Grant**
18 **Agreement No. 6-FG-32-00100.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 20 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Official, to wit; the Chairman is hereby authorized and**
21 **directed to negotiate said Construction Contract with the U.S. Bureau of**
22 **Reclamation, and that execution of the contract shall be subject to final approval by**
23 **the Council.**
- 24 **2. Any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be**
25 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH, Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,229.2 FOR; 188.3**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**
