

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2002 Bureau of Indian Affairs Realty Program Budget Amendment #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-283

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council through Resolution No. 01-634 authorized the Executive**
2 **Branch to expend funds for the Realty Program in the amount of \$43,797.00 +**
3 **\$4,800.00 (Start-up Funds) + Est. IDC \$8,455.88 = \$57,052.88; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch requests the Legislative Council to amend the budget approved**
5 **by Resolution No. 91-634 to adjust the amount to add FY 2001 (carry over) of**
6 **\$41,247.82 + \$48,597.00 (Direct FY 2002 funds) + Est. IDC \$11,560.80 = \$101,405.62; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Realty Program in this adjustments is including additional line items:**

8	712 - Gas, Oil, Coolants	\$1,470.00
9	771 - Repair and Maintenance Vehicle	\$ 961.40
10	774 - Computer Maintenance	\$3,000.00
11	810 - Professional Services	\$9,000.00; and

12 **WHEREAS, the Realty Program in this adjustment includes the correction of the Indirect Cost**
13 **percentage from 17.4% to 14.3%.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends**
15 **Resolution No. 91-634 and approves the adjustment of the budget for the Realty Office**
16 **from \$57,052.88 to \$101,405.62 by adding carry over funding from FY 2001.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is authorized to expend funds for the**
18 **program listed herein above in the amount indicated.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
21 **of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
22 **-0-NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
23 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
24 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
25 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




