1	WITTEREAS	the Westside Health Clinic Project, Dialysis Facility Project and the Headstart						
2	willing,	Facilities Project have been allocated funding on an annual basis for administration,						
3		salaries and other operational costs; and						
4	WHEREAS,	the three projects have been operating under the Department of Human Services and						
5		all three projects have had separated budgeted account numbers for similar						
6		purchases and costs; and						
7	WHEREAS,	the costs associated with three different budgets and three separate accounts for						
8		purchases and payment of salaries is not cost effective where the three projects could						
9		cost share utilities, salaries, and other administrative costs associated with						
10		managing the office; and						
11	WHEREAS,	the Special Projects through the Department of Human Services recommends the						
12		consolidation by establishing a total annual budget request, allocating that the						
13		Westside Health supplement the consolidated budget at 60%, the Headstart Facilities						
14		Project supplement the consolidated budget at 40% based on tasks by project; and						
15	WHEREAS,	the Dialysis Project has been considering a different funding approach and should						
16		not continue as a funding resource until a definite direction is approved; and						
17	WHEREAS,	the 60% supplement from the Westside Health Clinic Project is in the amount of						
18		\$163,270.14 and the 40% Headstart Facilities Project supplement is \$108,846.76						
19		bringing the total administrative consolidated budget total to \$272,116.90; and						
20	WHEREAS,	the restructuring will provide a more effective management approach to multiple						
21		projects allocating percentages of administrative fees on the larger project over						
22		multiple years.						
23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed							
24		and approved the following:						
25		1. Establishment of an FY 2002 annual budget for the Special Projects Office under						
26		the Department of Human Services by consolidating 60% of the administrative						
27		budget from the Westside Health Clinic Project budget, 40% of the administrative						
28		budget from the Headstart Facilities Project budget allocation.						
29		2. Authorize 60% of the Westside Health Clinic budget in the amount of \$163,270.14,
