RESOLUTION NO. 02-291

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Human Services is presently operating**
2 **the Division of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Program Component under P.L. 93-**
3 **638 Master Health Contract with the Public Health, Indian Health Services; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has notified the Division of Alcoholism & Substance**
5 **Abuse of a decrease in the Indirect Cost from 17.4% to 14.3% effective October 01,**
6 **2001; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has notified the Division of Alcoholism & Substance**
8 **Abuse of available carryover dollars for FY 2002 I.H.S. funds from FY'95 - FY'01 in the**
9 **sum of \$444,783.64 and \$2,000.00 will be used in FY 2002; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has notified the Division of Alcoholism & Substance**
11 **Abuse Program - Rehabilitation Aftercare Program (RAPA) of available non-recurring**
12 **funds awarded under Modification Sixty-One (61) to contract 249-96-0001, the**
13 **Nation's Master contract. This modification is executed in accordance with P.L. 93-**
14 **638, Section 108(e)(2)(A) for FY 2002 in the sum of \$8,487.00. This budget as submitted**
15 **was approved by the Executive Branch that operates the Department of Human**
16 **Services and now is being submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for**
17 **review and approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 19 **1. Approves the decrease in Indirect Cost from 17.4% to 14.3% effective October 01,**
20 **2001.**
- 21 **2. Approves carryover dollars for FY 2002 under I.H.S. for Alcoholism & Substance**
22 **Abuse Program Contract funds from FY'95 - FY '01 in the sum of \$2,000.00.**
- 23 **3. Approves the non-recurring funds awarded under Modification Sixty-One (61) to**
24 **Contract 249-96-0001, the Nation's Master Contract for I.H.S. Alcoholism &**
25 **Substance Abuse Rehabilitation Aftercare Program (RAPA) in the amount of**
26 **\$8,487.00.**
- 27 **4. Approves the budget amendment #1 with attached description for \$2,000.00 and**
28 **\$8,487.00.**
