

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of Assistance Amendment #E-98952001-01, Urban Initiative Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-299

1 **WHEREAS, the US EPA has offered an extension until April 30, 2002 for the Urban Initiative**
2 **Program (Assistance Amendment #E - 98952001 - 01); and**

3 **WHEREAS, the program period has been modified to January 21, 2000 through April 30, 2002.**

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
5 **Assistance Amendment #E-98952001 - 01 extending the Urban Initiative Project Period**
6 **to January 21, 2000 through April 30, 2002.**

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the TONEPA is authorized to expend funds to cover all costs**
8 **incurred prior to or on April 30, 2002 pursuant to Assistance Amendment #E - 98952001**
9 **- 01.**

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Chairman of the**
11 **Tohono O'odham Nation is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**
12 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the**
13 **grant shall be submitted to the Legislative Council for further prior approval.**

14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
15 **of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,333.85 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
16 **83.65 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f)**
17 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
18 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
19 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


