

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Ned L. Norris, Jr. to the TERO Commission for a Term Expiring
December 31, 2004)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-308

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered to select and fill vacancies on**
2 **the Papago Employment Rights Commission (a.k.a., "TERO Commission") pursuant**
3 **to the Papago Employment Rights Ordinance, Ordinance No. 01-85 ("TERO**
4 **Ordinance"), Section 6(B)(2); and**

5 **WHEREAS, Section 6 (C) of the TERO Ordinance further provides that "Commissioners shall be**
6 **appointed for terms of three years, or until their successors are appointed and**
7 **qualified, provided, however, that appointments to the Commission shall be made**
8 **in such a way and for such terms that their terms shall be staggered so that the terms**
9 **of office of only two Commissioners will end in any single year."; and**

10 **WHEREAS, Chester Delgado was appointed to the Commission with a term ending December 31,**
11 **2001 and he continues to serve until his successor is appointed and qualified**
12 **(Resolution No. 99-052); and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has been delegated authority to "review and**
14 **recommend action by the Legislative Council on appointments of . . . TERO**
15 **Commissioners" (Legislative Order No. 01-431); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has interviewed qualified applicants and**
17 **recommends the appointment of Ned L. Norris, Jr. to fill Chester Delgado's seat on the**
18 **Commission commencing upon the effective date of this resolution and ending**
19 **December 31, 2004 or until his successor is appointed and qualified.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby appoints**
21 **Ned L. Norris, Jr. to fill Chester Delgado's seat on the TERO Commission commencing**
22 **upon the effective date of this resolution and ending December 31, 2004 or until his**
23 **successor is appointed and qualified.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
25 **of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,259.3 FOR; 496.45**
26 **AGAINST; 661.75 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (b) & (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


