

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Modification of FY 2002 San Xavier District Budget to Accept the Nation's Housing
Grant per the Memorandum of Understanding)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-313

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 01-661, the Legislative Council appropriated and**
2 **authorized the expenditure of \$9,405,649.93 to complete housing rehabilitation**
3 **projects across the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 01-661 further authorized the Nation's Chairman or his designee "to**
5 **negotiate and execute any and all contracts or agreements with other parties,**
6 **including the Nation's districts, in order to ensure that projects are completed"; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Chairman did enter into the attached Memorandum of Agreement ("MOU") that**
8 **would allow the San Xavier District to use the \$286,589.70 appropriated and budgeted**
9 **in FY 2002 for projects within the District to rehabilitate homes which were identified**
10 **in the 1994 and 1996 federal HOME grant applications (Resolutions 01-661 and 02-**
11 **070); and**

12 **WHEREAS, of the twelve homes originally identified, three have had their housing needs met**
13 **with District financial assistance, therefore, the San Xavier District has proposed to**
14 **use the funds originally designated for these three homes to rehabilitate other needy**
15 **community members' homes; and**

16 **WHEREAS, other districts have expended district funds to rehabilitate homes which may have**
17 **originally been identified for rehabilitation with funds appropriated pursuant to**
18 **Resolution 01-661 and budgeted pursuant to Resolution No. 02-070; and**

19 **WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Legislative Council to modify the San Xavier District's FY 2002**
20 **Budget to transfer the \$286,589.70 allocated to the San Xavier District to pay for**
21 **beginning of the design and the rehabilitation in the budget period.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Legislative Council hereby**
23 **approves the transfer of \$286,589.70 to the San Xavier District pursuant to the**
24 **attached MOU and further approves the modification of the San Xavier District's FY**
25 **2002 Budget accordingly.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Legislative Council authorizes the San Xavier District**
27 **to identify and rehabilitate needy homes within the District that will be substituted**
28 **for the homes already renovated with District assistance provided that (1) the**

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Nation's Chairman and the San Xavier District modify the attached MOU to allow such a substitution and (2) future MOU's between the Nation and the districts that authorize housing rehabilitation pursuant to Resolution 01-661 shall also allow for the substitution of home renovation projects when the district has already renovated homes originally identified pursuant to Resolution 01-661.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,241.25 FOR; 1,176.25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) & (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
