

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Continuing Resolution for the Sif-Oidak District FY 2002 Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-318**

1 **WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District FY 2003 Budget is pending for further review by the**  
2 **Communities; and**

3 **WHEREAS, in order for the District to continue its operations pending the approval and adoption**  
4 **of a budget, it is recommended that a continuing resolution be authorized.**

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
6 **approve the Continuing Resolution for the Sif-Oidak District FY 2002 Budget until a**  
7 **new budget is approved and adopted.**

8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
9 **of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
10 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**  
11 **& (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
12 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
13 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
14 **Stat. 984).**




