

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Intergovernmental Agreement Concerning Technology Center)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-319

1 **WHEREAS, the Sif-Oidak District is one of the participants in a consortium identified as Central**
2 **Arizona Community Technology Initiative ("CACTI Project"), the purpose of which is**
3 **to secure funding for technology equipment and services which will be made**
4 **available to District members and the communities represented by other**
5 **participants; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Casa Grande Elementary School District No. 4 (the "School District") has been**
7 **awarded a Technology Community Center Grant (the "Grant") by the United States**
8 **Department of Education to establish a community technology center in each**
9 **community (the "Technology Center"); and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District is eligible to receive \$10,200. in funding under the Grant to**
11 **establish a Technology Center (the "Sif Oidak Technology Center"); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District is renovating the public library in the District to provide**
13 **sufficient space for operation of the Sif Oidak Technology Center; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak Technology Center will serve disadvantaged community members,**
15 **including at-risk children whose academic progress would benefit from academic**
16 **enrichment programs; the working poor and unemployed; and children and adults**
17 **without computers and the Internet in their homes; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the objectives of the Sif Oidak Technology Center are to help disadvantaged children**
19 **and adults (1) increase their educational attainment; (2) acquire marketable skills;**
20 **(3) obtain career awareness, preparation and experience; and (4) develop**
21 **entrepreneurial skills; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak Technology Center will be located in a secure building which will**
23 **provide members of the community free access to the equipment and services**
24 **available at the Center; and**

25 **WHEREAS, attached hereto is an Agreement Concerning Technology Center between the School**
26 **District and the Tohono O'odham Nation, for the benefit of the Sif Oidak District (the**
27 **"Agreement"); and**

28 **WHEREAS, the Human Resource Development Committee recommends approval of the**
29 **Agreement by the Legislative Council.**

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

2 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the Agreement in substantially
3 the form attached hereto.

4 2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Agreement.


5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH. Day
6 of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
7 -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
8 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
9 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
10 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


