1	WHEREAS,	on July 12, 2002, Legislative Council Chairwoman Rita Martinez did receive the
2		$resignation \ of SanXavierDistrictRepresentative\ to\ the\ Tohono\ O'odhamLegislative$
3		Council Crescencio "Tony" Encinas; and
4	WHEREAS,	prior to his resignation, Councilman Encinas served on the Legislative Cultural
5		Preservation, Housing, and Water Resources Committees; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation empowers the Legislative Council to
7		"establish rules and procedures to regulate all meetings of standing committees"
8		and to "appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and
9		powers of committees" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(a) and (b)); and
10	WHEREAS,	as a matter of practice, the Legislative Council has appointed a resigning
11		representative's successor to that representative's vacant committee seats.
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
13		appoints Councilwoman Felicia Nuñez to the Legislative Cultural Preservation,
14		Housing, and Water Resources Committees.
15	BE IT FINA	LLY ORDERED that Legislative Orders No. 01-269, 01-272, and 01-277 (appointing,
16		respectively, Cultural Preservation, Housing, and Water Resources Committee
17		members) and Legislative Order No. 02-168 (Appointing Councilman Encinas to
18		committee memberships) are hereby superceded only to the extent that
19		Councilwoman Felicia Nuñez is appointed to former Councilman Encinas' vacated
20		Committee memberships effective immediately.
