

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2003 Division of Early Childhood Development - Title XX Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-326

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation provides services to improve the availability,**
2 **affordability and quality of child care for early childhood development including**
3 **before and after school services through funding provided by the Arizona**
4 **Department of Economic Security's (ADES) Planned Social Services Block Grant (SSBG)**
5 **Title XX Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the nurturance of its young**
7 **members by providing for their welfare through various programs and services**
8 **designed to meet their special needs; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is supportive of continuing this program for**
10 **the benefit of its young members; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Division of Early Childhood Development will utilize the FY 2002 allocation of**
12 **\$125,103.00 as the FY 2003 planning allocation until the ADES provides notice of the**
13 **final allocation at which time the Program will submit a budget modification for**
14 **further review and approval if the funding allocation should change; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Division of Early Childhood Development is submitting**
16 **for review and approval the FY 2003 Title XX Budget and supporting documentation**
17 **to request authority to incur expenditures from July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
19 **authorize the Division of Early Childhood Development to incur expenditures from**
20 **July 1, 2002 to June 30, 2003 under the FY 2003 ADES SSBG Title XX Block Grant**
21 **Program.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the FY 2003 funding level change, the Division of Early**
23 **Childhood Development will submit a budget modification for review and approval**
24 **to reflect the final allocation level.**

25 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
26 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
27 **the contract.**


