(Accepting the Donation of the Tucson Electric Power Company and Authorizing  
Expenditure of Funds)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-328**

1 **WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation declared a State of Drought and Fire Emergency on May**  
2 **30, 2002; and**


3 **WHEREAS, in response, Tucson Electric Power Company generously donated \$15,000 to assist the**  
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation in drought relief efforts; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Office of the Chairman has prepared a budget for expenditure of the TEP funds**  
6 **to be placed in the newly re-activated account #01-3010, as attached and**  
7 **incorporated by this reference.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
9 **gratefully accepts the donation of \$15,000 from the Tucson Electric Power Company**  
10 **and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to expend the funds according to the**  
11 **attached budget.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15<sup>th</sup> Day**  
13 **of JULY, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
14 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**  
15 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
16 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
17 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


