1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation receives a Special Diabetes Program for Indians grant;**
2 **and**

3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-657, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
4 **Healthy O'odham Promotion Program FY 2002 budget modification #1; and**

5 **WHEREAS, to cover anticipated costs to co-host the 6th Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness**
6 **Conference, scheduled for August 1-3, the Healthy O'odham Promotion Program**
7 **requests FY 2002 budget modification #2; and**


8 **WHEREAS, the requested FY 2002 budget modification #2 requires amendment to the narrative**
9 **for line item 11-1453-810, Professional Services, by adding justification for a caterer**
10 **and two keynote speakers for the 6th Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness Conference.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 12 **1. Approves the Healthy O'odham Promotion Program Fiscal Year 2002 budget**
13 **modification #2.**
14 **2. Approves the additional justification to 11-1453-810 Professional Services in**
15 **support of the 6th Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness Conference.**

21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**


