

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2002-Title VI USDA, Nutrition Services Incentive Program October 1, 2001
through September 30, 2002)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-338

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the Elders of the**
2 **Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Program has been made possible in**
4 **part by Title VI of the Older American's Act of 1978 as amended and U.S. Department**
5 **of Agriculture, Nutrition Services Incentive Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the services provided to the elders has been beneficial and services continue to be**
7 **necessary to provide nutrition and socialization support; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Senior Services Program has prepared budgets to utilize Title VI Cash in Lieu of**
9 **Commodities funds of \$4,458.00 from USDA Reimbursement for FY 2001 and \$6,261.00**
10 **from USDA Grant to continue to provide nutrition and socialization support services**
11 **to eligible elders.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 13 **1. That it hereby approves the budgets utilizing Title VI Cash in Lieu of Commodities**
14 **funds of \$4,458.00 from USDA Reimbursement for FY 2001 and \$6,261.00 from**
15 **USDA Grant to maintain services it has proposed per attachments in light of the**
16 **requirements and regulations.**
- 17 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: The Chairman is hereby authorized**
18 **to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments**
19 **affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for**
20 **further prior approval by this Council.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05th. Day**
22 **of AUGUST, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
27 **Stat. 984).**
