

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amendment to the FY 2002 Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, Women, Infants, & Children (WIC) Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-340

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently providing preventive health care for women,
2 infants, and children; and

3 WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States Department
4 of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit Women, Infants, & Children; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with
6 Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants, & Children
7 (WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2001 through September 30, 2006;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, due to an increase in the ITCA/WIC agreement, based on the increase of participants,
10 an increase of funding to \$123,300.00 from \$116,400.00; and


11 WHEREAS, a budget modification is submitted for review and approval by the Department of
12 Human Services, Division of Community Health.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

- 14 1. It hereby approves the increase in funding of the WIC Program and expenditures
15 in accordance with the attached budget modification.
- 16 2. Decrease of the Indirect cost rate from 17.4% to 14.3 %.
- 17 3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman
18 and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this
19 contract and to expend funds when received.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05th Day
21 of AUGUST, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).
