(Acceptance of Assistance Amendment #X - 98933601 - 3, Border Project - Environmental Coordinator Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-357

1 WHEREAS, the US EPA has offered an extension of the Border Project until December 31, 2002
2 (Grants Assistance Amendment #X - 98933601 - 3); and

3 WHEREAS, there is an ongoing need for the Tribal Border Environmental Coordination Project
4 to develop environmental infrastructure, identify and update specific border issues;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, there is savings available to continue the Tribal Border Environmental Coordination
7 Project; and

8 WHEREAS, the program period has been modified to June 30, 1999 through December 31, 2002.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
10 approves Grant Assistance Amendment #X - 98933601 - 3, extending the Border
11 Project - Environmental Coordinator Program to June 30, 1999 through December 31,
12 2002.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the TONEPA is authorized to expend all available funds awarded
14 pursuant to Grant Assistance Amendment #X - 98933601 - 3.

15 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, that the Chairman of the
16 Tohono O'odham Nation is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
17 provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of
18 the grant shall be submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for further
19 prior approval.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08th. Day
21 of AUGUST, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,001.4 FOR; -0-
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 416.1 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
23 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).
