

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Tohono O'odham Nation Chief Judge Betsy Norris as the Nation's Arizona
Sovereignty Protection Spokesperson and Representative)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-379

1 WHEREAS, on December 7, 2001, the Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 01-614,
2 "Amending Resolution No. 01-558 to Appoint Tohono O'odham Nation Chief Judge
3 Malcolm Escalante as the Nation's Arizona Sovereignty Protection Spokesperson and
4 Representative"; and

5 WHEREAS, one purpose of Resolution No. 01-558 was "to designate representatives to present
6 [the Nation's position concerning tribal sovereignty] at the state and national levels";
7 and

8 WHEREAS, effective August 23, 2002, Chief Judge Malcolm Escalante resigned his office, thereby
9 leaving the Nation's state sovereignty protection representative position vacant; and

10 WHEREAS, there is ongoing need to educate and coordinate with Arizona officials in an effort to
11 protect and expand the Nation's sovereignty; and

12 WHEREAS, the Legislative Judiciary Committee recommends that the Nation's current Chief
13 Judge, Betsy Norris, be appointed as the Nation's Arizona sovereignty protection
14 representative.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
16 hereby appoints Tohono O'odham Judicial Court Chief Judge Betsy Norris as the
17 Nation's Arizona sovereignty protection representative to fill the vacancy left by Chief
18 Judge Malcolm Escalante's resignation from office.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day
20 of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
21 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
22 Section 1 (f), (c)(1), and (c)(6) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
23 adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
24 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
25 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


