

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting the Grant from the USDA to Bolster Food and Agriculture Homeland Security
Protections on Tribal Lands, and Authorizing Expenditure of Funds)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-380

1 **WHEREAS, on August 12, 2002, the Agriculture Secretary Ann M. Veneman announced that the**
2 **United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) is distributing \$1 million through**
3 **cooperative agreements to bolster food and agriculture homeland security**
4 **protections on tribal lands; and**

5 **WHEREAS, on August 12, 2002, the Tohono O'odham Nation was informed that its share of these**
6 **funds amounts to \$100,000; and**


7 **WHEREAS, the Office of the Chairman has prepared a budget for expenditure of the USDA funds**
8 **as attached and incorporated by this reference; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the budget is to be administrated by the Nation's Natural Resources Department,**
10 **Range Conservation and Management Program.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
12 **accepts the grant of \$100,000 from the USDA and authorizes the Chairman of the**
13 **Nation to expend the funds according to the attached budget, with this budget being**
14 **administered by the Range Conservation and Management Program of the Nation's**
15 **Natural Resources Department.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10th Day**
17 **of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
20 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
21 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
22 **Stat. 984).**


