

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Pisinemo District FY 2003 Budget use of Mining Royalties)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-388

1 **WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled session of the Legislative Council, Pisinemo District did**
2 **present a proposal for use of the Mining Royalties monies; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did review the proposal of Pisinemo District;**
4 **and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did determine that the proposal to use the**
6 **Mining Royalties of \$53,362.38, is a sufficient amount to continue to provide**
7 **operations, projects and services to the Youth and Elders of the District as follows:**

8	Youth Budget	\$17,880.00
9	Elder Budget	\$28,100.00
10	Total	\$45,980.00

11 **WHEREAS, the remaining amount of \$7,382.38 will then be used to supplement Pisinemo**
12 **District's Operational Budget for Fiscal Year 2003; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Pisinemo District Council did approve this proposal through Pisinemo District**
14 **Council Resolution 2002-17 dated August 13, 2002.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does approve**
16 **the use of \$53,362.38 in Mining Royalties for Pisinemo District Youth, Elder Budgets**
17 **and to supplement Pisinemo District FY 2003 Operational Budget.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day**
19 **of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; 0-**
20 **AGAINST; 0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
21 **1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
22 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
23 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
24 **Stat. 984).**


