under Gila River Adjudication Program for Period Ending September 30, 2002)

1	WHEREAS,	Natural Resources Consulting Engineers ("NRCE") was recommended by experts in the
2		field of Indian water law as uniquely and exceptionally qualified to perform the
3		technical studies necessary to prepare Indian water claims for settlement and
4		litigation; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a contract with NRCE pursuant to a tribal
6		budget approved by the Legislative Council for fiscal year 1991 (the "NRCE Contract");
7		and
8	WHEREAS,	the purpose of the NRCE Contract was to prepare a study which quantified the water
9		rights and assessed damages to such rights in the Sif Oidak and surrounding Districts
10		(the "Sif Oidak Claim"); and
11	WHEREAS,	beginning in fiscal year 1991 the Nation has been awarded federal funding pursuant
12		to a P.L. 93-638 Contract ("638 Contract") to continue the assessment of the Sif Oidak
13		Claims, a project now designated as the Gila River Adjudication Program (the
14		"Program"); and
15	WHEREAS,	all 93-638 funding to the Nation through the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA"), including
16		funding under the 638 Contract, is now administered under a Contract with the BIA,
17		designated as Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071 (the "BIA Master Contract"); and
18	WHEREAS,	the technical work on the Program has been exclusively performed by NRCE pursuant
19		to a subcontract with the Nation, as modified by Amendment Nos. 1 through 9 thereto
20		(the "NRCE Subcontract"); and
21	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution 99-342, Modification No. 54 was executed
22		extending the BIA Master Contract through September 30, 2002; and
23	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Modification No. 113, attached hereto, the sum of \$50,000 (the "Available
24		Funds") was added to the BIA Master Contract for expenditure in the Program through
25		September 30, 2002; and
26	WHEREAS,	continuation of the Program requires that the Legislative Council approve a budget
27		for expenditure of the Available Funds through September 30, 2002; and

5	the NRCE Subcontract, in the form attached hereto, which authorizes the						
6	expenditure of \$50,000 for all work performed under the Subcontract from						
7	October 1, 2001 through September 30, 2002.						
8	2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute Amendment No.						
9	10 to the NRCE Subcontract.
