

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing FY 2003 Expenditures from the SAWRSA Trust Fund for Continuation of**  
**Efforts to Complete Tribal Responsibilities and Obligations Related to Utilization of**  
**Central Arizona Project Water and Irrigation Systems)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-396

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council, by means of Resolution No. 99-334,**  
2 **authorized and directed the completion of tribal responsibilities and obligations**  
3 **related to construction of facilities for utilization of Central Arizona Project water**  
4 **and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District; and**

5 **WHEREAS, portions of work identified for FY 2002 were not completed and are being budgeted**  
6 **for into the FY 2003 as reflected in the attached budget and justification; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office submitted the attached budget and justification for FY 2003**  
8 **to continue the scope of work authorized under Resolution No. 99-334 for an amount**  
9 **of \$171,650.28; and**


10 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office requests from the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council,**  
11 **approval of funding from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to enable completion of tribal**  
12 **responsibilities and obligations related to utilization of Central Arizona Project**  
13 **water and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
15 **approves the funding request and authorizes the expenditures in the amount of**  
16 **\$171,650.28 to complete tasks indicated in the attached budget for the fiscal year**  
17 **2003.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$171,650.28 are hereby appropriated from**  
19 **the SAWRSA Trust Fund to cover expenditures during the period from October 1, 2002**  
20 **through September 30, 2003.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
22 **of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,148.85 FOR; -0-**  
23 **AGAINST; 268.65 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
24 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
27 **Stat. 984).**


