

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 01-211, "Setting Aside \$8,791,778 for FY 2002, 2003 and
2004 Operations of Tohono O'odham Community College and appropriating
\$3,320,165 for FY 2002")

RESOLUTION NO. 02-405

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 01-211, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
2 **appropriated \$8,791,778 from the Desert Diamond Savings Account, Account No. 68-**
3 **01-101-1067514 (the "Appropriated Amount"), for the operations of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Community College (the "Project"); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Appropriated Amount was deposited in a segregated investment account, Account**
6 **No. 68-01-101-0380535 (the "Investment Account"), and available to pay the**
7 **designated costs; and**

8 **WHEREAS, interest and other earnings in the Investment Account were not dedicated to payment**
9 **of such costs.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

11 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends Resolution 01-211 as**
12 **follows:**

13 **(a) The second resolved clause is repealed.**

14 **(b) All interest and other earnings on the Principal Amount (as defined below) in**
15 **the Investment Account for the Nation's fiscal years 2001 through 2004 shall be**
16 **retained by the Tohono O'odham Nation and available to fund governmental**
17 **operations and projects of the Nation.**

18 **(c) Such accrued interest and other earnings shall be transferred to the General**
19 **Fund (Account No. 68-01-101-1067508) for fiscal years 2001 and 2002 in a lump**
20 **sum, and thereafter on a quarterly basis.**

21 **2. For purposes of this Resolution, the term "Principal Amount" means the**
22 **Appropriated Amount less any withdrawal of funds from the Appropriated**
23 **Amount for expenditure on the Project pursuant to an approved budget or other**
24 **authority granted by the Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day**
26 **of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,250.2 FOR; 167.3**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
