1 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee, Executive Review Committee and Tri-Branch
2 Representatives reviewed the revenue projection and available revenues for FY 2003;

4 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee, Executive Review Committee and Tri-Branch
5 Representatives recommends adoption of FY 2003 revenues projected and available
6 in the amount of \$43,416,895 to funds the Nation's budget for 2003.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
8 approves the attached projected revenues in the amount of \$43,416,895 for the
9 purpose of funding the FY 2003 budgets of the Tohono O'odham Nation.


10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day
11 of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,331.6 FOR; 925.2
12 AGAINST; 160.7 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
13 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
14 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
16 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
