

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Modify the Solid Waste Management Program's revenue budget (83-0003) to create  
new line items)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-416**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign authority, desires**  
2 **to manage and regulate the storage, collection, recycling, transportation and disposal**  
3 **of solid waste and certain hazardous waste on lands within the boundaries of the**  
4 **Nation in order to protect the environment, the natural resources, the political**  
5 **integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the health, safety and welfare of its**  
6 **members and persons present on the Nation's lands; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council") adopted the Solid**  
8 **Waste Management Code and Solid Waste Management Plan ("Plan") on February 12,**  
9 **1997, which in part, established the Solid Waste Management Program, ("SWMP"); and**

10 **WHEREAS, SWMP has implemented the section of the Plan by creating weekly solid waste**  
11 **collections from 700 bins serving over 100 villages, businesses and agencies and**  
12 **hauling, on an average, 480 tons of solid waste per month to EPA permitted landfills**  
13 **located off of the Nation's lands; and**

14 **WHEREAS, SWMP originally serviced 9 of the 11 districts but now provides bulky waste removal**  
15 **and construction debris services for San Xavier District and San Lucy District; and**

16 **WHEREAS, SWMP has collected fees for services and recycling revenue from the sale of**  
17 **recyclables and these funds have been deposited in a dedicated account**  
18 **#000252452099 with the Bank of America as directed in Resolution No. 98-236, and said**  
19 **resolution states that the funds are to be used for program expenditures as budgeted**  
20 **in 83-0003 SWMP revenue budget; and**

21 **WHEREAS, SWMP is finding that services continue to expand and SWMP will exhaust its allocated**  
22 **funds under budget 01-1097 before the end of FY 2002.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
24 **creation of additional line items for the SWMP revenue budget as follows: 751 - lease**  
25 **rental, 770 - repair maintenance equipment and 771 - repair maintenance vehicles**  
26 **and 810 - professional services and allocates funds to be distributed as indicated in the**  
27 **attached budget modification.**
