

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Funding the TOUA Subsidy Implementation Plan)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-417

1 WHEREAS, on June 28, 1997, the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation approved Initiative No. IN-
2 01-97 (the "Initiative) which sets aside \$1 million to establish a welfare fund to
3 provide qualified elderly and low-income members of the Nation with assistance
4 payments covering the cost of utility services provided by the Tohono O'odham Utility
5 Authority; and

6 WHEREAS, in order to implement the Initiative, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did
7 adopt the Initiative Funding and Implementation Plan of October 14, 1997 by
8 Resolution No. 97-451; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve the TOUA Subsidy
10 Implementation Plan of November 3, 1998 by Resolution No. 98-473; and


11 WHEREAS, TOUA has applied \$2,998,583 to eligible members through September 2002 and the
12 available funding is exhausted; and

13 WHEREAS, TOUA projects that the need for the Subsidy will be \$1 million for FY 2003.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
15 the transfer of \$1 million from the Gaming Savings to TOUA for FY 2003.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day
17 of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,626.75 FOR;
18 790.75 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
19 by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
20 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
21 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
22 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


