16	WHEREAS,	${\bf unobligated funds in the Cultural Center/Museum Investment Account (Account No.)}$				
17		68-01-107-0335877) are available to contribute as the Nation's share of the additional				
18		funding to the AIGA Proposition 202 campaign; and				
19	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority has committed to reducing its operating				
20		expenses in Fiscal Year 2003 by one million dollars so that that amount may be used				
21		by the Nation for purposes of replenishing the Cultural Center/Museum Investment				
22		Account in the amount of one million dollars in Fiscal Year 2003.

24		1. One million dollars is authorized to be transferred from the Cultural				
25		Center/Museum Investment Account (Account No. 68-01-107-0335877) to the

27		additional funding to the AIGA Proposition 202 campaign in Fiscal Year 2003.				
28		2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to expend the transferred funds				
29		according to the budget attached and incorporated by this reference.
