

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting to extend Baboquivari District Administration and Communities
FY 02 Supplemental Budgets)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-429

1 **WHEREAS, an allocation of gaming revenue funds was provided to each of the eleven Districts**
2 **with Baboquivari District being approved for \$500,000.00 by Tohono O'odham**
3 **Legislative Council Resolution No. 01-624; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the six (6) communities within Baboquivari District still have uncompleted projects**
5 **and unmet needs; and**


6 **WHEREAS, the District Administration and the communities of Artesia-Little Tucson, Fresnal**
7 **Canyon, Choulic, Coldfields, Topawa and South Komelic have Supplemental funds**
8 **available to still serve members of the community; and**

9 **WHEREAS, at the September 9th District meeting, the respective community representatives did**
10 **request for an extension to carry forward all remaining administration and**
11 **community supplemental monies to December 31, 2003.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
13 **an extension for all Baboquivari District Administration and community supplement**
14 **budgets to be carried over to FY 2003 to complete projects and meet the needs of the**
15 **community members.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH. Day**
17 **of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
19 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
21 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
22 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




