

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Baboquivari District FY 2003 Budgets)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-430

1 WHEREAS, on September 09, 2002, the Baboquivari District Council did meet and approved the
2 FY 2003 Baboquivari District budgets; and

3 WHEREAS, the District Council did approve gaming/mining revenues in the amount of
4 \$643,793.60 to be divided among the six (6) communities and the District
5 Administration, with 40% to administration and 60% to be divided among the
6 communities; and

7 WHEREAS, the following distribution of gaming/mining revenues is allocated to the six (6)
8 communities and administration in the total amount of \$643,793.60:

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
19 the Baboquivari District FY 2003 Budget in the amount of \$643,793.60 to be
20 distributed with 40% to Baboquivari District Administration in the amount of
21 \$257,517.44 and 60% to be divided among the six (6) communities of the Baboquivari
22 District each in the amount of \$64,379.36.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30TH. Day
24 of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
26 Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
27 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
