

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing Continuation of the Gu-Vo District Fiscal Year 2001 Supplement Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-431

1 WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council at their regular meeting on September 21, 2002,  
2 did discuss the Fiscal Year (FY) 2001 Supplement Budget; and

3 WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council has determined that it is in the best interest to  
4 request of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council a continuation of FY 2001  
5 Supplemental Budget; and

6 WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Governing Council desires to continue expending funds until the  
7 Supplement Budget is exhausted; and


8 WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District does reserve the right to modify funds as required.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves  
10 a continuation of the Gu-Vo District's FY 2001 Supplement Budget through FY 2003.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Gu-Vo  
12 District to modify funds as required within the budget.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
14 of SEPTEMBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-  
15 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
16 Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
17 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
19 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


