

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization of the Johnson-O'Malley Educational Services F.Y. 2002 Budget  
Modification #2-638 Indirect Cost Reduction & Final Allocation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-434

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, per Indirect Cost Negotiation Agreement, has directed  
2 the Johnson-O'Malley Program to recalculate IDC from 17.4% to 14.3%; and


3 WHEREAS, the Johnson-O'Malley Program has received its final allocation in the amount of  
4 \$154,354.00, which is an increase in the amount of \$1,574.00, to the direct cost  
5 budgeted in F.Y. 2002.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the  
7 reduction for indirect cost, in the amount of \$4,130.70 and the increase in the amount  
8 of \$1,574.00 to the Johnson-O'Malley Program F.Y. 2002 Budget.

9 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Johnson-O'Malley Program budget of \$175,965.22 has decreased  
10 to \$173,408.52 for F.Y. 2002, in accordance with the attached budget.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01<sup>ST</sup> Day  
12 of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-  
13 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
14 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
15 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
16 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
17 Stat. 984).




