

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 2003 Department of Health and Human Services Budgets)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-437**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**  
2 **Department of Health and Human Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating a Child**  
4 **Care Program to provide child care services to its young tribal members; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating a Head**  
6 **Start Program to provide educational, health, mental health and parent involvement**  
7 **services to children, three to five years of age; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated and wishes to continue operating a Child**  
9 **Welfare Services Program to promote safe and stable families and to provide child**  
10 **welfare services; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has approved Resolution No. 99-059 granting the Executive**  
12 **authorization to submit grant fund application with the condition that if awarded,**  
13 **approval is obtained from the Legislative Council for acceptance of award and**  
14 **approval to expend funds; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Headstart grant requires a 10% match, which was approved through Resolution**  
16 **No. 02-427; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Title IV-B, Subparts 1 & 2 grant require a 25% match, which the Nation matches**  
18 **through the P.L. 93-638 master contract, specifically the Family Preservation**  
19 **Program, as authorized by P.L. 93-638; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the following**  
21 **budgets as attached and incorporated by this reference, to be effective October 01,**  
22 **2002 through September 30, 2003 and request authorization to expend funds:**

23 **1. FY 2003 CCDF Mandatory Administration - \$61,221.13 + \$8,754.62 (IDC) =**  
24 **\$69,975.75.**

25 **2. FY 2003 CCDF Mandatory Program - \$573,519.86 + \$27,620.39 (IDC) = \$601,140.25.**

26 **3. FY 2003 CCDF Discretionary Administration - \$72,131.16 + \$10,314.76 (IDC) =**  
27 **\$82,445.92.**



11 **funds for the programs listed herein above and as attached in the amounts indicated,**  
12 **effective October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2003.**

13 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01<sup>ST</sup>. Day**  
14 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
15 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
16 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
17 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
18 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
19 **Stat. 984).**


