

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Phoenix Indian School Trust Fund Distribution 2000 Funds
Carry Over for 2003 Child Welfare Division Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-438

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was notified in November, 1999 by the Executive Director
2 of the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, Mr. John R. Lewis, that the Nation is scheduled
3 to receive its first distribution of the Arizona Inter-Tribal Trust Fund Distribution in
4 the amount of \$400,000.00 in December, 1999 under Public Law 100-969, Arizona
5 Inter-Tribal and Navajo Trust Fund; and

6 WHEREAS, Legislative Council approved \$174,565.60 be allocated to the Department of Human
7 Service Child Welfare in Resolution No. 2000-253; and

8 WHEREAS, presently there is carry over funds available from the year 2000 allocation of
9 \$75,253.38.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:

- 11 1. The 2000 funds carry over allocation of \$75,223.38 to continue funding Child
12 Welfare Specialist position and the Administrative Assistant position with
13 operational cost.
- 14 2. The Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairman and Vice-Chairman
15 and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and
16 expend the grant.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day
18 of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,333.85 FOR; -0-
19 AGAINST; 83.65 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
21 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
23 Stat. 984).
