7		(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2006;

9	WHEREAS,	the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue				
10		to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of				
11		individuals at risk.				
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:				
13		1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-				
14		Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible				
15		women, infants and children.				
16		2. The Memorandum of Agreement shall continue through September 30, 2003.				
17		3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Official, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman				
18		and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this				
19		contract associated with this program and to expend funds when received.
