

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2003 ITCA Women, Infants, & Children (WIC) Program Proposal)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-439

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for women, infants,**
2 **and children during fiscal year 2002; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States Department**
4 **of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit women, infants and children; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with**
6 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants, and Children**
7 **(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2006;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue**
10 **to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of**
11 **individuals at risk.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 13 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-**
14 **Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible**
15 **women, infants and children.**
- 16 **2. The Memorandum of Agreement shall continue through September 30, 2003.**
- 17 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Official, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman**
18 **and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this**
19 **contract associated with this program and to expend funds when received.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day**
21 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**


