


**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(FY 2003 United States Department of Agriculture Budgets)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-440

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the  
2 United States Department of Agriculture (USDA); and  
3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Food Distribution Program  
4 to assist eligible families with commodity foods; and  
5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been providing nutrition and socialization support  
6 services to eligible elders through the Title VI, Nutrition Services Incentive Program;  
7 and  
8 WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the following  
9 budgets as attached and incorporated by this reference, to be effective October 01,  
10 2002 through September 30, 2003 and request authorization to expend the funds:  
11 1. Food Distribution Program - \$158,475.94 + \$22,662.06 (IDC) = \$181,138.00  
12 2. Title VI, Nutrition Services Incentive Program - \$6,261.00.  
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend  
14 funds for the program listed herein above and as attached in the amounts indicated,  
15 effective October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2003.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01<sup>ST</sup> Day  
17 of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-  
18 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
19 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
20 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
21 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
22 Stat. 984).


