

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2003 State of Arizona Budgets)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-441

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**
2 **State of Arizona; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Education through the Child and Adult Care Food**
4 **Program - Food Service Agreement provides reimbursement of funds for food costs**
5 **incurred based on the guidelines identified in the agreement; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been providing Arizona Long Term Care Services**
7 **(ALTCS) case management services since June 1996 and has been receiving**
8 **reimbursement from the State of Arizona; and**


9 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the**
10 **following budgets as attached and incorporated by this reference, to be effective**
11 **October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2003 and request authorization to expend**
12 **the funds:**

- 13 **1. Child and Adult Care Food Program - \$40,000.00.**
14 **2. Arizona Long Term Care Services Program - \$149,293.08.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend**
16 **funds for the programs listed herein above and as attached in the amounts indicated,**
17 **effective October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2003.**



22 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**




