

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2003 Title VI, Part A Budget Amendment #1/Modification #1)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-442

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the elders of the**
2 **Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Program has been made possible in**
4 **part by Title VI of the Older American's Act of 1978 as amended; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Title VI, Part A Budget Amendment#1/Modification #1 has been prepared to**
6 **increase funds from \$128,550 to \$132,850 (an increase of \$4,300) so the budget can**
7 **reflect the funding amount; and**


8 **WHEREAS, the budget amendment #1/modification #1 also reflects Indirect Cost adjustments**
9 **from 17.4% to 14.3% and utilizing savings of the adjustment for other line items.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative that it hereby approves:**

- 11 **1. The FY 2003 Title VI, Part A Budget Amendment #1/Modification #1 to increase the**
12 **funds from \$128,550 to \$132,850 (an increase of \$4,300) as reflected in the**
13 **attached budget.**
- 14 **2. The budget Amendment #1/Modification #1 Indirect Cost adjustments from 17.4%**
15 **to 14.3% and to utilize the savings of the adjustment for other line items.**
- 16 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation official, to wit: The Chairman or designated official**
17 **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that**
18 **any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be**
19 **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day**
21 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,232.8 FOR; 184.7**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**


