

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2003 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-444

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since**
2 **1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono O'odham; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office has been**
4 **supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is essential to**
6 **eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono**
7 **O'odham Nation.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
9 **approves the continued supplemental funding for the Tribal Employment Rights**
10 **Office from the Equal Opportunity Commission.**

11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall commence on October 01, 2002**
12 **through September 30, 2003.**

13 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
14 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby**
15 **authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
16 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted**
17 **for further prior approval by this Council.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day**
20 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
22 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
23 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
24 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
25 **Stat. 984).**




