

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Approval of the FY 2003 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation
Program Base Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-445

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has previously supported the**
2 **Nation's Education Department in submitting a grant proposal and establishing a**
3 **vocational rehabilitation program under Resolution Number 98-202; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under the Rehabilitation Services**
5 **Administration's Section 121 (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for**
6 **American Indians with Disabilities) of the Rehabilitation Act and received grant**
7 **notification number H250G980011-02; and**

8 **WHEREAS, services under the Tohono O'odham Nation's Vocational Rehabilitation Program,**
9 **who reside on the Tohono O'odham Nation, will be provided to eligible American**
10 **Indians with disabilities, with enrolled Tohono O'odham Nation members being first**
11 **priority; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,**
13 **priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities and informed choice of eligible American**
14 **Indians so that they may prepare for and engage in gainful employment.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the FY**
16 **2003 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program budget in the**
17 **amount of \$433,997.00 awarded to the program under PR/AWARD#H250G980011-02.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman is authorized to execute and expend the grant**
20 **award and provide continued culturally appropriate vocational rehabilitation**
21 **services to its eligible consumers, provided however, that any amendments affecting**
22 **the funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further approval.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day**
25 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**
