9		who reside on the Tohono O'odham Nation, will be provided to eligible American
10		Indians with disabilities, with enrolled Tohono O'odham Nation members being first
11		priority; and
12	WHEREAS,	the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,
13		priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities and informed choice of eligible American
14		Indians so that they may prepare for and engage in gainful employment.
15	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the FY
16		2003 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program budget in the
17		amount of \$433,997.00 awarded to the program under PR/AWARD#H250G980011-02.
18	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
19		Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman is authorized to execute and expend the grant
20		award and provide continued culturally appropriate vocational rehabilitation
21		services to its eligible consumers, provided however, that any amendments affecting
22		the funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further approval.
