

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Budget Justification for the FY 2003 Bureau of Reclamation Fund Account 11-5015  
Water Resources Study Program Continuation Under Public Law 93-638 Grant for  
a Comprehensive Water Study)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-451**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) entered into a Grant Agreement with the United**  
2 **States Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation (BOR), Phoenix Area office**  
3 **under the Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-**  
4 **638, for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation,**  
5 **designated as Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 (Grant Agreement); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement has been extended for one (1) year beginning on**  
7 **October 1, 2002 and expiring on September 30, 2003; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget for fiscal year 2003 in the**  
9 **amount of \$1,253,150.40; and**

10 **WHEREAS, this budget has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and the Budget and**  
11 **Finance Committee and is recommended for approval by the Legislative Council.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**  
13 **carryover of savings of Bureau of Reclamation funds provided by the P.L. 93-638**  
14 **Bureau of Reclamation Grant, for the Water Resources Study Program in the total**  
15 **amount of \$1,253,150.40.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the total budget funding for fiscal year 2003 of \$1,253,150.40 for the**  
17 **Water Resources Study Program is approved in accordance with the budget attached**  
18 **hereto.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01<sup>ST</sup> Day**  
20 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**  
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
22 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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
