

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval and Acceptance of the Application for an EPA grant to sample Northern
Sonora, Mexico, O'odham Community Drinking Water Sources)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-453

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment**
2 **and safeguarding the health and well being of the Nation's members; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Article VI (i)(2) of the Nation's Constitution delineates the authority of the Legislative**
4 **Council to manage, protect, preserve and regulate the surface and ground waters of**
5 **the Nation; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) maintains the Clean**
7 **Water Act Border Studies grant program whose purpose is to assist Tribes and States**
8 **in establishing and maintaining adequate measures for detection, prevention and**
9 **control of surface and ground water pollution; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Water Resources Study Program has prepared an application for**
11 **Northern Sonora water sampling funding and has been awarded the funds.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts**
13 **the award for \$30,000.00 from the United States Environmental Protection Agency**
14 **(USEPA) to implement the Northern Sonora Water Sampling Program.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council acknowledges that the 5% matching**
16 **amount of \$3,754 is a requirement for these funds and will be met through in-kind**
17 **services provided by the Water Resources Study Program from the BOR P.L. 93-638**
18 **grant, agreement number 98-FG-32-00800.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
20 **Nation's Chairman, Vice Chairman or any designated official are hereby authorized**
21 **to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting**
22 **the funding levels of the grant shall be submitted to the Legislative Council for further**
23 **prior approval.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Water Resources Study Program is authorized to expend funds**
25 **from this grant, beginning on October 1, 2002.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day**
27 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417,5 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section I (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
32 **Stat. 984).**






