

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization to Expend carryover Indian Health Services (IHS) funds for FY 2003
IHS Account 11-5016 Water Resources Study Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-454

1 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program (WRSP) of the Natural Resources Department has
2 accumulated savings in fiscal year 2002 funding provided by the Nation's, TOUA, and
3 WRSP MOA with IHS, in the amount of \$101,699.93; and

4 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program IHS budget and MOA was approved under
5 Resolution No. 01-313 and has proposed a budget in fiscal year 2003 in the amount of
6 \$74,216.64 to augment its budget line items for Lease/Rentals, RM Equipment, RM
7 Vehicles, and Professional Services; and


8 WHEREAS, this budget and its savings proposal has been reviewed by the Water Resources
9 Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and it is recommended for
10 approval by the Legislative Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
12 carryover of savings of IHS funds provided by the Nation's MOA with IHS, for the Water
13 Resources Study Program in the total amount of \$101,699.93.

14 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the total budget funding for fiscal year 2003 of \$74,216.64 for the
15 Water Resources Study Program is approved in accordance with the budget attached
16 hereto.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST Day
18 of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
21 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
23 Stat. 984).




