
RESOLUTION NO. 02-456

1 **WHEREAS, the Pascua-Yaqui Tribe has made a gift to the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Campaign**
2 **in the amount of \$10,000.00; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Colorado River Indian Tribes has made a gift to the Tohono O'odham Citizenship**
4 **Campaign in the amount of \$5,000.00; and**
5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is most appreciative of these generous gifts from the**
6 **Pascua-Yaqui Tribe and the Colorado River Indian Tribes in support of the important**
7 **work of the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Campaign.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 9 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes receipt of the gift from the**
10 **Pascua-Yaqui Tribe in the amount of \$10,000.00 and receipt of the gift from the**
11 **Colorado River Indian Tribes in the amount of \$5,000.00.**
12 **2. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Executive Office to**
13 **expend these gifts in support of the Tohono O'odham Citizenship Campaign**
14 **pursuant to the following budget:**
15 **(1) Rent and Utilities.....\$8,822.00**
16 **(September and October rent at \$4,100.00 X 2 = \$8,200.00 plus September and**
17 **October utilities at \$311.00 per month X 2 = \$622.00; \$8,200.00 + \$622.00 =**
18 **\$8,822.00.**
19 **(2) General Campaign Expenses.....\$6,178.00**
20 **(Including, but not limited to, duplication, literature printing and production,**
21 **travel, office supplies and equipment, food and related expenses.)**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
23 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,095.2 FOR; 72.25**
24 **AGAINST; 250.05 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






