2		applied for and been awarded a grant from the United States Department of
3		Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Veterinary Services ("APHIS")
4		in the amount of \$100,000 for use between October 1, 2002 and September 30, 2003;
5		and
6	WHEREAS,	the grant is entitled "Food and Agriculture Homeland Security on Tribal Lands," and
7		will be expended by the Range Conservation and Management Program of the Natural
8		Resources Department on equipment (digital cameras and global positioning system
9		receivers), fencing along the international border, intrusion alarms for Tohono
10		O'odham Utility Authority facilities, increased veterinary services throughout the
11		Nation, and related purposes; and
12	WHEREAS,	expenditure of the grant must be in conformance with an intergovernmental
13		agreement entitled "Cooperative Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation
14		and the United States Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection
15		Service Veterinary Service (APHIS)", a copy of which is attached hereto and
16		incorporated herein by reference; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Agriculture Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the Cooperative
18		Agreement and recommends approval by the Legislative Council.
19	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
20		approves the Cooperative Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the
21		United States Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service
22		Veterinary Service (APHIS) in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman
23		of the Nation to sign the Cooperative Agreement and any further documents or
24		amendments reasonably necessary to implement the grant program referred to in
25		the Cooperative Agreement.
