

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Lobbying Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and
Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc.)

RESOLUTION NO. 02-469

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude**
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . with private**
3 **persons” (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council recognizes the need for legislative and administrative**
5 **advocacy concerning federal programs, services, and other federal activities**
6 **affecting the Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the firm of Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc. has continued to provide such**
8 **services in Fiscal Year 2001, including: advising the Nation regarding federal**
9 **appropriations, legislation, and programs; acting as a liaison with the United States**
10 **Executive and Legislative Branches; arranging meetings with federal officials;**
11 **providing regular client memoranda on federal activities affecting the Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation has appropriated \$35,000**
13 **pursuant to Resolution No. 02-468 for the purpose of funding these services for the**
14 **period beginning October 1, 2002 and ending March 30, 2003.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that**
16 **the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Chairwoman of the Legislative**
17 **Council are hereby authorized to execute the attached “Service Agreement” between**
18 **the Nation and Ducheneaux, Taylor & Associates, Inc.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to Resolution No. 02-468, this Service**
20 **Agreement shall be effective October 1, 2002 and shall terminate March 30, 2003.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Service Agreement’s total cost, including all fees,**
22 **costs, and expenses for the period from October 1, 2002 through March 30, 2003 shall**
23 **not exceed \$35,000.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any proposed amendments affecting the Service**
25 **Agreement’s funding levels or termination date shall be submitted to the Legislative**
26 **Council for approval.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
28 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,025.35 FOR; 247.65**
29 **AGAINST; 144.5 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**


