

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Authorizing Fiscal Year 2003 Initiative Administration Budgets,
and the continued authorization for Initiative Related Activities)**

RESOLUTION NO. 02-470

1 **WHEREAS, Initiative IN-01-97 requires that the Nation provide for the annual administrative**
2 **cost of implementing the provisions of the initiative, and related activities mandated**
3 **by the Initiative; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared a Fiscal Year 2003 budget to continue its Initiative**
5 **Administration, and the on-going related activities of the Initiative; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the total Fiscal Year 2003 budget for Initiative Administration, in the amount of**
7 **\$1,692,053.48 provides for the following;**

9	ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM	\$795,659.06
10	ACCOUNTING DEPARTMENT - PER CAPITA PAYMENT	\$103,947.08

12	ENROLLMENT- INITIATIVE PAYMENT ROLL	\$296,757.15
13	ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT- OIM INITIATIVE	\$153,554.56

14 **WHEREAS, the total Fiscal Year 2003 budget for Initiative Related Activities, in the amount of**
15 **\$ 18,345,006.72 provides for the following;**

16	Youth Recreation Centers Construction	\$15,503,445.72
17	EDD - BUSINESS GRANTS	\$ 2,841,561.00

18 **WHEREAS, the budgets have been presented to the respective Legislative Oversight Committees**
19 **for review.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
21 **Executive Branch Fiscal Year 2003 Initiative Administration Budget, in the full**
22 **amount of \$1,692,053.48 is hereby approved and authorized to be expended**
23 **accordingly.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the unexpended amount of \$609,576.47 from Fiscal Year 2002**
25 **appropriation and authorization is hereby re-authorized and that the additional**
26 **amount required for the Initiative Administration Budget, \$ 1,082,477.01, is hereby**
27 **appropriated from the Nation's Gaming Savings Reserve.**

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Executive Branch**
29 **Fiscal Year 2003 Initiative Related Activities Budget, in the full amount of**
30 **\$18,345,006.72, as presented in Schedule 2, is hereby approved and authorized to be**
31 **expended accordingly.**

32 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the unexpended amount of \$15,460,492.75 and \$ 658,439.00 from**
33 **Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation and authorization is hereby re-authorized and that**
34 **the additional amount required for the Initiative Related Activities Budget,**

4 of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,256.8 FOR; -0-
5 AGAINST; 160.7 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
6 Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
7 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
9 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
