

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Certifying Councilwoman Mary Flores as Chairwoman and Councilwoman Frances Miguel
as Vice Chairwoman of the Cultural Preservation Committee)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 02-471

1 **WHEREAS, on September 9, 2002 Legislative Council Chairwoman Rita Martinez did receive the**
2 **resignation of Gu Achi District Representative to the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
3 **Council Alex J. Ramon, which was effective October 4, 2002; and**

4 **WHEREAS, prior to his resignation, Councilman Ramon served on the Legislative Council**
5 **Cultural Preservation Committee; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Councilman Ramon was elected to the Chairmanship of the Cultural Preservation**
7 **Committee; that office became vacant due to his resignation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, individual Legislative Committees are empowered to caucus and elect Legislative**
9 **Committee Officers (Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,**
10 **Article XII, Section 3.J.); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee did caucus on October 7, 2002 and elected**
12 **Councilwoman Mary Flores as Chairwoman and Councilwoman Frances Miguel as**
13 **Vice Chairwoman.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **certifies Councilwoman Mary Flores as Chairwoman and Councilwoman Frances**
16 **Miguel as Vice Chairwoman of the Cultural Preservation Committee.**


17 **BE IT FINALLY ORDERED that Legislative Order No. 02-173 (certifying Alex Ramon to the**
18 **Chairmanship and Councilwoman Mary Flores as Vice Chairwoman of the Cultural**
19 **Preservation Committee) is hereby superceded.**

20 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH, Day of**
21 **OCTOBER 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,337.15 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; 80.35 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (a) & (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
