
1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has historically supported the Venito Garcia**
2 **Library and Archives, the library agency for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the Venito Garcia Library and**
4 **Archives' application for a Content Creation and Storage Grant on behalf of the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Nation for the indicated Phase Two grant donations from the Native**
6 **American Access to Technology Program of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation,**
7 **and agrees to the following:**

- 8 1. **That the grant donations will be used to address information creation and access**
9 **need of the community; and**
- 10 2. **That the granted computers, equipment, and software will be available to all**
11 **community members during regular library hours; and**
- 12 3. **That the value of the grant donations will be an increase to other current and**
13 **anticipated technology funding and will not replace previously budgeted items;**
14 **and**
- 15 4. **That efforts will be made to ensure that all computers and peripheral equipment**
16 **are kept fully operational and appropriately supplied and that there will be**
17 **adequate public funding for the proper maintenance, security and eventual**
18 **replacement of the equipment provided by the grant.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts**
20 **the grant donations for the Venito Garcia Library and Archives and authorizes**
21 **acceptance and use of the grant donations in a total amount of \$13,684.00.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
23 **of OCTOBER, 2002 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01]ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
25 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**






